Course Contents

This qualification represents the minimum requirements for an individual commencing a career in Fisheries Operations either at the regional ,National ,Provincial or Local level. It is an appropriate level for an individual undertaking Fishery related work, or in a probationary period in employment or learning for the first time.

The qualification will have application for people working:

- For a regional, government or local authorities in the Fishery Industry

Course Duration

- 10 weeks

Entry Requirements

- Personnel working as Fisheries Officers in government or non government organizations responsible for fishing compliance

Course Venues

- Courses are delivered in Kavieng at the National Fisheries College.

Enrolment Procedures

- Applicants should complete and return the application on the back of this brochure.
- Provincial Fisheries Offices may seek entry on behalf of Aquaculture farmers or persons willing to enter the industry and applicants from their work force where required.
- Other requirements as required under NFC Policies and Procedures will be made known upon request.

Course Fees

- Contact National Fisheries College for information regarding fees.

Course Rules

- The National Fisheries College has Rules by which all Trainees should abide by once they are accepted for training at the NFC. These Rules act as a deterrent so each Trainee can concentrate on learning and acquiring skills rather than concentrate on unnecessary activities that do not assist with a Trainees learning on Campus.

Course Assessment

- All courses for fishing vessel crew and seafood industry workers are based on agreed industry competency standards .
- The competency standard include general knowledge and practical assessment.
- Validation on all assessment will be done when a course is completed.

Job Role Qualification

This qualification specifies the competencies relevant to people working at a local level in a support role to government ,an agency or organisation that has legislated responsibility for the management of fisheries, both wild catch and aquaculture.

Job role

Typically, the qualification will have application for people in Local Level Governments who strive for environmentally sustainable usage of the fisheries, and marine and freshwater environments in their regions.

The Certificate II in Fisheries has been developed for Local Fisheries Officers who can assist the local communities they are in to manage their resources in a sustainable manner .Assist with fishing projects and other relevant fishing related matters. In addition to be equipped with relevant reporting tools to assist the government keep abreast of marine and freshwater environments in their regions.
